To be eligible to apply to the Order of Omega, you must :

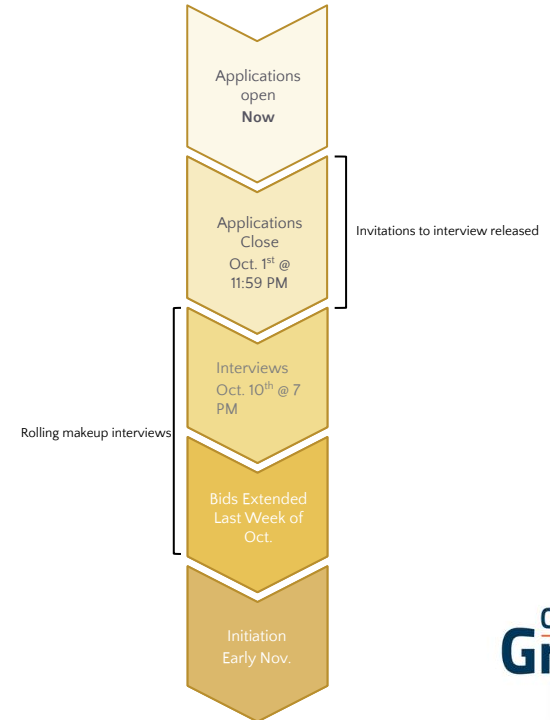
- Be a second-year student or above enrolled in Case Western Reserve University

## What is the EDF?

The Emergency Dues Fund is an Order of Omega run fund that can be utilized by members of Greek Life to cover part or all of their semester dues, when the need for assistance comes from an unexpected circumstance. Some situations that have been granted in the past would be a chapter member's car breaking down and then needing to spend money on their car meaning that they no longer had the money budgeted to pay for dues.

Each EDF application is first made anonymous by Tiffany Hall in the Greek Life Office to eliminate any identifying characteristics, such as name, gender, pronouns, and chapter, so as to limit bias as much as possible.

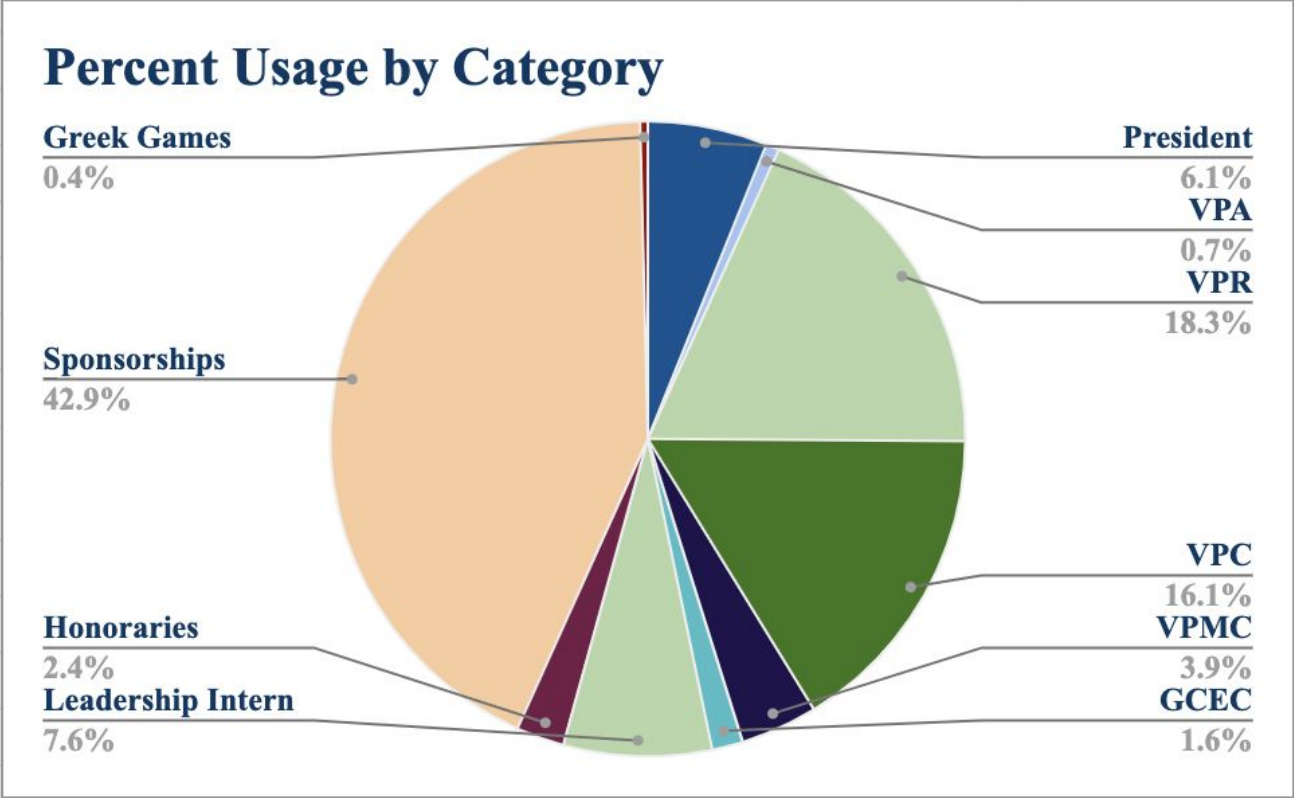
