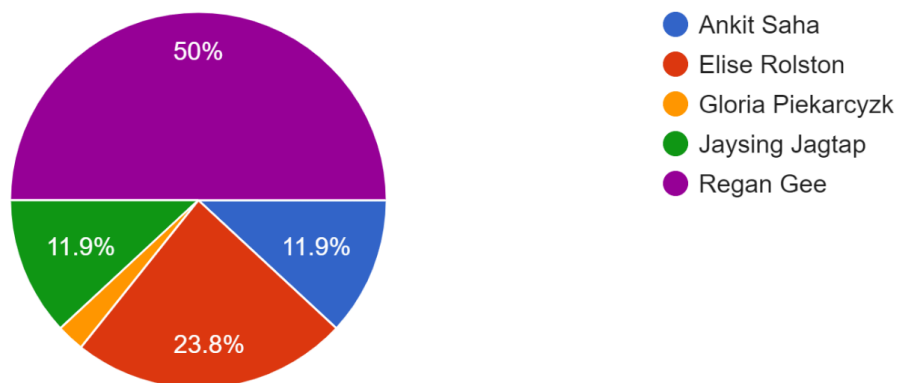

## School Reports/Discussion Topics

- **Title IX**

- **Alicia** (President of the Biomedical Graduate Student Organization): have been trying to communicate about the Title IX issues with the Office of Equity for the past year with our administration; would like to see if GSC can come up with some sort of open letter to President Kaler and Provost group asking them to acknowledge the DOJ settlement pertaining to the Title IX against CWRU on a public forum; would also like to have graduate students be a part of a potential internal review board for the Office of Equity to ensure they have proper policies
- **Michelle** (GCAS GSC Rep): need to have someone (ombudsman) who protects and advocates specifically for graduate students on campus; ombudsman can be a neutral negotiator in disagreements between faculty and students; want to have these things and policies in place to support graduate and professional students; potentially create and integrate a 5-year plan into the bylaws outlining the goals that CWRU should have that GSC is behind (each E-Board is kept accountable)
- **Joey** (SOM GSC Rep): a little apprehensive to amending the GSC bylaws; the actions taken by the E-Board must remain flexible; don't want any bylaw to lock E-Board into not being able to adapt to the current situation on an annual basis; resolution voted on by the General Assembly would work best for GSC because it clarifies what position the GA takes every year and allows next GA to amend it

- **Hostility**

- General feelings of the board being hostile towards the GA
- It has been mostly at our previous meetings and years past
