To facilitate the events, volunteers are needed for two key roles: Captain, Volunteer

A minimum of four hours of service is requested for volunteers. Commitment of captain volunteers estimated 5-15 hours to include event development in advance of competition.

Benefits for Volunteers: Earn community service hours, Enjoy a Continental Breakfast, Lunch and free T-shirt

Captain: Captains take on the challenge of developing an event, executing, managing, and scoring the event with the support of volunteers. Captains develop the event assigned in advance of the competition date using the description provided, arranging for supplies and equipment (e.g. scales, chemicals, insect specimens, etc.) with the Gelfand STEM Center office.

Event Volunteer: Volunteers administer and/or proctor written events, help manage and evaluate hands-on competitions, record competition results in scoring center, attend registration tables for arriving teams, check in event captains and volunteers, manage event supplies, distribute awards at closing ceremonies, take candid photos of events and create slide program, **or** fill in where needed.
