The **Voting Outreach Team**, organized by the CWRU Center for Civic Engagement & Learning (CCEL), is a non-partisan volunteer group that actively promotes voter registration and voter turnout of CWRU students. Members build capacity of CCEL and the CWRU student Andrew Goodman Foundation (AGF) Vote Everywhere Ambassadors to help CWRU students participate in political engagement.

Volunteer Responsibilities

- Assist with voter registration promotion, such as National Voter Registration Day.
- Providing brief 'Voter Registration 101' presentations in class or to student organizations (on request).
- Assist with Election Day shuttles to the polls by serving as a voter education assistant to make sure students have correct voting identification, etc.

Additional Details

What is the time commitment?

Flexible! You can sign-up for events and participate as your schedule allows.

Do I need past experience with voter registration?

Students do *not* need to have previous experience registering people to vote – only a passion for encouraging others to get involved! Voter registration training (typically one hour in length) is provided.

Can I promote a particular political candidate while participating?

Voting Outreach Team members must remain non-partisan during all team activities, so it is not possible to hand out candidate flyers, wear political t-shirts, etc. during voter registration drives. You are welcome to be involved with a political campaign or party on your own time, just not during the time you are representing the Voting Outreach Team.

How do I sign-up?

Fill out a brief <u>online application</u>. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
