

ONLINE BIOETHICS DATABASES

- **PubMed** — comprises over 24 million citations for biomedical literature from MEDLINE, life science journals, and online books. View recently added documents in [core bioethics journals](#) or limit to [free full text documents](#). You can also search using the [bioethics subset](#).
- **EthxWeb** — our richly indexed database that consolidates interdisciplinary bioethics material covering 1974-2009, with extensive [subject bibliographies in bioethics](#). [Explore more databases prepared by the BRL](#).
- **PhilPapers** — a comprehensive directory of online philosophical articles and books by academic philosophers.
- **Web of Science** — provides you access to reliable, integrated, multidisciplinary research. *Available online if your library has purchased a subscription to the database.*
- **Global Digital Library on Ethics** — Globethics.net offers access to a large number of resources on ethics.
- **Global Ethics Observatory** — The Global Ethics Observatory is a system of databases with worldwide coverage in bioethics and other areas of applied ethics.
- **Philosopher's Index** — the primary index to the literature of philosophy. *Available online if your library has purchased a subscription to the database.*
- **ProQuest Research Library** — a multidisciplinary resource featuring a diversified mix of sources.
- **BELIT (Bioethics Literature Database)** — provides access to approximately 470,000 records from integrated German, American and French databases.
- **EthicShare** — a community website to research, share, collaborate, and participate in the field of ethics.
- **Bioethics Observatory in the Institute of Life Sciences at the Catholic University of Valencia** — provides reports and news with ethical implications based on research findings.
- **Google Scholar** — there are pros and cons, but it can be a useful tool to supplement your research using search alerts.

WHAT'S A CITATION MANAGER, AND WHY USE ONE?

Citation Managers (sometimes called Reference Managers) are used to store the references you collect for your research projects.

Along with organizing your references, a citation manager can also:

- create formatted citations to insert as you write a paper
- create bibliographies
- facilitate collaboration
- Save PDFs

ENDNOTE

Strengths

It's been around for a while, and is widely used by researchers to organize citations for papers and theses.

Highly customizable.

Can handle a large amount of references.

Weaknesses

Desk and online versions have significant differences between them.

*You need the online version (EndNote Basic) to be able to share your libraries with colleagues.

Type

Desktop software

And also free web interface, [EndNote Basic](#),

Cost

Deeply discounted through [UTech Software Center](#)

EndNote Online is free, but isn't as robust.

How does it work?

Export references from compatible databases into EndNote.

What kind of records can you import and organize?

Best with records in traditional formats (articles, books, etc.).

PDFs and other file types can also be stored in the records.

EndNote Desktop

- Ability to work offline, without an internet connection.
- More databases offer direct exporting of search results to EndNote Desktop version.

CREATE GROUPS

CREATE GROUPS

By default, EndNote places references into the **Unfiled** group. You can create up to 5,000 groups to organize your references in any way that works for you.

- Select the references you want to group.
- Click on **Add to group** from the drop-down menu and select **New group**.
- Name the new group and click **OK**.

Note: You can place a reference in multiple groups. To see which group(s) a given reference is currently in, click the **Folder icon** below the reference.

FIND DUPLICATES

ELIMINATE DUPLICATE REFERENCES

It is possible to have duplicate records in your library. To identify and delete them, use the **Find Duplicates** link under the **Organize** tab. EndNote compares the Author, Year, Title, and Reference Type fields when identifying duplicates.

SHARE REFERENCES

SHARE REFERENCES WITH OTHER ENDNOTE USERS

Use the **Manage My Groups** link under the **Organize** tab. Click the **Manage Sharing** button next to the group you'd like to share.

Enter the email addresses of the people with whom you'd like to share.

Note: Any individual you share your group with *must* have an EndNote account in order to view references. Enter the email address they use to access EndNote.

Choose whether to give your colleagues **Read-only** access, or **Read & Write** access. Click **Apply**.

- Read-only access allows designated users to view references, use them in Word documents, or copy them to their own library.
- Read & Write access allows the designated user to add, change, or remove references in the group, as well as anything Read-only access allows.






