### CONSTITUTION OF THE ATLANTIS CLASSICS CLUB

### **ARTICLE I**

The title of the organization shall be Atlantis Classics Club or Atlantis for short.

### **ARTICLE II**

The function of Atlantis is to make the field of Classics available to everyone, whether or not they have the time or desire to take courses.

### **ARTICLE III**

Membership in Atlantis is open to all undergraduate and graduate students, faculty, and staff at Case Western Reserve University.

### **ARTICLE IV**

Atlantis will host at least one event a month, at the discretion of the President.

## ARTICLE V

- A. Atlantis officers shall be President, Vice-President/Risk Manager, and Treasurer.
- B. Vacancies in the officers during the academic year will be filled by the remaining members of the executive board.

## **ARTICLE VI**

- A. Selection of officers for the coming academic year will be by application and executive board approval after Spring break. The length of terms shall be fall and spring of the following year.
- B. In the event of a tie, the candidate with the lowest number of votes will be eliminated, and the vote will be taken again. This process will be repeated until only two candidates remain. In the event of another tie, the deciding vote will go to the President.

### **ARTICLE VII**

The duties of club advisor shall be to aid in decision-making and executive board decisions, if necessary. The requirements are to show genuine interest in Atlantis and be faculty in (or associated with) the Classics department.

### **ARTICLE VIII**

The constitution must be approved by a simple majority of club members.

### **ARTICLE IX**

Amendments can be recommended to the executive board and must be approved by a majority of members.

# ARTICLE X

Atlantis will not discriminate against any person based on gender, gender identity, race/ethnicity, sexual orientation, political alignment, religion, disability, or veterans.
